AGILITY COURSE TEST -- an AKC Agility Test for Beginner Agility Teams

Ready. Set. ACT Now!!!

The Dog Obedience Club of Hollywood is hosting an AKC Agility Course Test (ACT) on **Saturday, September 28** and **Sunday, September 29, 2024** at our **Annual Canine Round-Up!** This titling event is designed specifically for beginning agility dogs and their handlers. The American Kennel Club (AKC) ACT program is a fun way to put your training to the test in a real agility trial setting. And, you can earn a title or more in one weekend!

There are four levels of ACT events: ACT1, ACT2, ACT1J, and ACT2J. ACT 1 & ACT 1J are designed to test beginning level sequencing and performance skills. ACT 2 & ACT 2J require more skill and navigation of more obstacles. We will have two runs each of ACT1J and ACT2J on Saturday and two runs each of ACT1 and ACT2 on Sunday giving you the chance to earn AKC titles.

You'll know how to complete an AKC entry form, how to check in at the ring, learn about getting your dog measured, enter and exit the ring, and handle your dog with a judge nearby after this event.

Pre-entries must be received by 6pm on 9/16/24 by the Trial Secretary. Day of Show entries will be accepted. Cost is \$15/run for pre-entries and \$20/run for day of show entries (must enter 30 minutes prior to start). Dogs must be 15 months old to enter. Entries limited to 60 per day.

AKC pre-registration not required, AKC registration information will be available on-site.

ACT FACT Sheet

What is ACT?

The Agility Course Test (ACT) is an entry level agility event designed to introduce and welcome beginning dogs and their handlers to the AKC sport of agility. It is a great way for owners to bond with their dogs and teach discipline. There are 4 levels of ACT events – ACT1, ACT2, ACT1J & ACT2J.

Who can participate?

Any person with a dog that is 15 months old or older that meets requirements for a regular agility trial can enter these events (requirements available on www.akc.org). They do not need to be AKC registered at the time of entry. Dog cannot have achieved any AKC Agility title.

How to Achieve an ACT Title

ACT1

- Run a course at any jump height, 10-12 obstacles
- A-Frame (5'), Table, Jumps, Open Tunnels
- Complete the course in 60 seconds, no missed contacts, no dropped bars, no obstacle attempted more than 3 times, no more than 3 wrong courses
- Run outs and refusals not judged
- 2 qualifying scores

ACT2

- Run a course at any jump height, 11-13 obstacles
- A-Frame (5'), Teeter, Dog Walk (allowed), Tire, Table, Jumps, Spread Jumps (1), Weave Poles (6), Open Tunnels
- Complete the course in 70 seconds, no missed contacts, no dropped bars, no obstacle attempted more than 3 times, no more than 3 wrong courses
- Run outs and refusals not judged
- 2 qualifying scores

ACT 1J

- Run a course at any jump height, 10-12 obstacles
- Bar jumps, Panel jump, Tire jump, Open Tunnels
- Complete the course in 50 seconds, no dropped bars, no obstacle attempted more than 3 times, no more than 3 wrong courses
- Run outs and refusals not judged
- 2 qualifying scores

ACT 2J

- Run a course at any jump height, 11-13 obstacles
- Bar jumps, Panel jump, Tire jump, Double bar jump (1), Triple bar jump (1), Broad jump (1), Weave poles (6), Open Tunnels
- Complete the course in 60 seconds, no dropped bars, no obstacle attempted more than 3 times, no more than 3 wrong courses
- Run outs and refusals not judged
- 2 qualifying scores
