July 21, 2022

Summary of Actions and Motions

Action Items:

- Commissioner Anthony Jones contacted the department and has resigned.
- The chair recognizes Carrie Kennedy and her work to secure and place a drop box for upper bay rockfish watermen to place their striped bass tags and cards in Aberdeen.
- The department is requesting the commission for the consideration of a representative at an upcoming Chesapeake Bay Stock Assessment Committee workshop dealing with crab reproductive success and recruitment within the Bay. The meeting is being held at Fort Monroe, VA on Sep. 20. The rep would speak for Maryland. Contact Mike or Paul if you have an interest, it does not have to be a commissioner.
- Mike Luisi will step down as Acting Director of Fishing and Boating Service, Lynn Fegley will take on the role starting September 1. Mike will continue with his regular duties on Sep. 1.
- *Motion to name Steve Lay as commission's Liaison on the Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission by Moochie Gilmer.* Steve Lay denied the motion and is asking for another individual. Appointment would be valid for up to four years, same as all SFAC appointments.
- *Motion to name Bill Scerbo as commission's Liaison on the Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission by Russell Dize.* Bill Scerbo denied the motion.
- Sonny Gwin volunteered to attend the Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission until another commissioner accepts a nomination. There were no objections.
- This will probably be Sgt. Brimer's and Sgt. Tyler's last commission meeting. Cpt. Matthew Corbin and Sgt. Sarah Grice will report out at future meetings.
- Director Luisi reported to the NRP that he was informed of a number of boats working/fishing near the bay bridge during the recreational striped bass closer period and asked them to pass it along to the regional officers.
- Commissioners are asked to provide feedback to the department on the draft Oyster Management Plan amendment by August 31. If you have feedback, please email comments to fisheriespubliccomment.dnr@maryland.gov. If you have any questions please contact Jodi Baxter at jodi.baxter@maryland.gov.
- The department is asking the industry to improve their harvest reporting rates, the current rates are unacceptable. The department believes the FACTS program is the best reporting option moving forward. To

- The department requested comment from the commission on fisheries-related items it is currently scoping, including [commercial crab pot line clarifications](#). Please review your handouts and send comments to Sarah Widman (sarah.widman@maryland.gov), or fisheriespubliccomment.dnr@maryland.gov.
- The chair thanks commissioners Brown, Gwin, and Powley for their time working with him and the department on the Shrimp Workgroup.
- The department will broadcast an announcement requesting applications for the pilot commercial shrimp fishery. The announcement will be made via email and social media.
- The state is expecting a striped bass rebuilding program to be established under ASMFC over the next two years which will call for the reduction in fishing mortality (both recreational and commercial fisheries). Be prepared for a reduction to the states take of the coast wide stock. The state will meet with all stakeholders on this topic after ASMFC's meetings in November.
- The State is expecting a reduction to its commercial menhaden allocation and is attempting to minimize interference with the commercial fishery in Maryland. Be on the lookout for upcoming hearings.
- Commissioner Gilmer announced he is organizing a meeting to hold discussions on how to address the growing blue catfish population in bay waters and tributaries. Various stakeholders were contacted and are willingly to meet to hold conversations on options to control the population. Commissioner Brown volunteered to participate. The department will be brought into future meetings when appropriate.

Because the rule has been interpreted/enforced in different ways, it must be clarified. The proposed clarification is authorized by Natural Resources Article, §4-1015(a), Annotated Code of Maryland and justified through the historical context of the fishery.

Fishing and Boating Services Regulatory Scoping July 2022

Please review the following possible regulatory changes. The department is looking for your advice on how to proceed with scoping (i.e., open houses, web feedback only, etc.). The department's normal process is to scope each topic on the department's website, through GovDelivery Communications, and on social media (Facebook and Twitter).

This format is consistent with the legislation that became effective July 1, 2019, that requires us to provide information that answers questions (who, what, where, when, and why) to help stakeholders/small businesses understand and comply with a regulatory idea.

A google comment form will be created for each topic and be available for the comment period.

BLUE CRABS – Addition of Juneteenth Holiday

What is being considered?

Commercial crabbers are currently allowed to begin crabbing an hour earlier than their usual start time on federal holidays in the summer months between Memorial Day and Labor Day, as well as the day immediately prior to those holidays. The holidays are named in the regulation. The department is proposing to modify the regulation to include the recently recognized federal holiday Juneteenth National Independence Day, as it falls within this timeframe.

Why is this change necessary?

The intention of the regulation is to allow commercial crabbers to have extra time to crab on and immediately before summer holidays when demand for crabs is often highest. Juneteenth National Independence Day was established as a federal holiday in 2021 and will be observed annually on June 19th. Therefore, the holiday falls within the summer timeframe (Memorial Day to Labor Day) and should be included in the regulation.

Who will this affect?

Commercial crabbers who crab in the Chesapeake Bay and its tidal tributaries and the Atlantic Ocean, its coastal bays and their tributaries.

When would this be effective?

The department projects that this change could be effective in the spring of 2023. However, the exact date cannot be determined. The department will follow our normal proposal procedures if this concept moves forward.

Has this change been discussed with stakeholders?

No.

BLUE CRABS – Crab Pot Set Time Clarification

What is being considered?

The department is considering a modification to the description of legal crabbing times which would clarify that commercial crab pots on board a boat at the end of the legal crabbing hours may only be set during the legal crabbing hours and for one hour after the end of the legal crabbing hours.

Why is this change necessary?

Individuals have asked for clarification on when crab pots may be set due to the current wording of the regulation. The current language allows for crabs to be removed from crab pots during the established legal crabbing times and for pots already on board the vessel to be set for one hour after the end of the legal crabbing times. The change being considered will clarify that those are the only times crab pots may be set, which should be clearer to all affected individuals and remove any ambiguity as to when crab pots may be set.

Who will this affect?

Commercial harvesters who crab pot in the Chesapeake Bay and its tidal tributaries.

When would this be effective?

The department projects that this change could be effective by the spring of 2023, however the exact date cannot be determined. The department will follow our normal scoping and proposal procedures if this concept moves forward.

Has this change been discussed with stakeholders?

No.

GEAR – Projectile Gear

What is being considered?

The department is considering adding residences to the safety zone list for projectile gears, reducing the safety zone from 100 yards to 50 yards, and establishing that the length of retrieval lines may not exceed 35 yards.

Why is this change necessary?

Recreational bowfishing for Northern snakehead has become a popular activity in recent years. Many individuals who participate in this activity find snakeheads in small creeks and coves and fish for them at night. The increase in calls to department staff and Natural Resources Police has made the department aware of potential conflicts.

Currently, an individual who uses a projectile gear, as referenced in COMAR 08.02.25.02, .03, and .05, such as a bow and arrow or crossbow, must stay 100 yards away from a human being, a private or public swimming area, an international diving flag, an occupied duck blind, or another vessel, unless you first have permission from all people in those locations. Homes are not included in this list. Especially when fishing at night, it is difficult to know if a person is present in a house or on their property. By adding dwellings to the safety zone, the potential for an individual being present on the property is addressed. In conjunction with adding dwellings to the safety zone list, the department is considering reducing the safety zone from 100 yards to 50 yards and requiring that retrieval lines not be longer than 35 yards. Fifty yards is the minimum safety zone for archery hunting on land in many counties in the state. Additionally, retrieval lines currently in use are between 25 and 35 yards, meaning that a projectile would not be able to go past 35 yards. These three changes would result in enhanced public safety by including dwellings in the safety zone list and by limiting the maximum length of the retrieval line. The changes would also ensure that individuals engaged in the legal harvest of fish with projectile gear – typically invasive species such as Northern snakehead and blue catfish – will continue to be able to access waters and habitat types in which those species are found.

Who will this affect?

This change would affect commercial harvesters and recreational anglers who use projectile gears.

When would this be effective?

The department projects that this change could be effective in the winter of 2022-2023. However, the exact date cannot be determined. The department will follow our normal proposal procedures if this concept moves forward.

Has this change been discussed with stakeholders?

The concept of adding dwellings to the safety zone was previously scoped with the Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission and Tidal Fisheries Advisory Commission at their July 2022 meetings. The idea was subsequently scoped with the public in August 2022. Based on public feedback, the department has revised the original concept.

OYSTERS – Fees for Purchasing, Hauling, and Planting Fresh Oyster Shell

What is being considered?

The department is considering altering the procedure for establishing the fair market value the department pays for fresh oyster shells and transportation and placement of fresh oyster shells. The current value is set by regulation; the department is considering changing the regulation to set the value by public notice.

Why is this change necessary?

Current regulation sets the rate to be paid by the department to any person for the hauling and planting of fresh oyster shell at 25 cents per bushel and the rate to be paid to purchase fresh oyster shell at \$2 per bushel, for a total of \$2.25 per bushel. The actual 2022 cost to purchase out-of-state shell, transport, and plant shells was \$7.25 per bushel. As a result, Maryland shucking houses are not selling to the department because of these current values established in regulation. Changing the process of establishing the rate paid by public notice each year, rather than setting the rate in regulation, will allow the department to pay a competitive fee based on current market conditions. If the rate set by the department is actually reflective of market conditions, more Maryland shucking houses may be willing to sell to the department, thereby allowing the department more access to shells.

Who will this affect?

Maryland oyster shucking businesses.

When would this be effective?

The department projects that this change could be effective by the spring of 2023, however the exact date cannot be determined. The department will follow our normal scoping and proposal procedures if this concept moves forward.

Has this change been discussed with stakeholders?

Many discussions within OAC, TFAC, Statewide Oyster Industry Committee, and the County Oyster Committees have occurred all of which express interest in obtaining more shell. The need for the department to be able to pay actual market rates has been recognized in these conversations.

PENALTIES – Updates to Commercial and Recreational Penalty Systems

What is being considered?

The department is considering updates to its commercial and recreational penalty schedules.

1. Recreational updates

- Add penalty for shark handling violations – 90 day suspension for second or subsequent offense
- Add the following violations to the penalty schedule with 180 day suspensions:
 - Possession of fish with head and tail removed while fishing in nontidal waters
 - Catching black bass by means other than angling (hook and line) in nontidal waters
- Add the following violations to the penalty schedule with 1 year suspensions:
 - Violations in trout catch-and-release areas
 - Culling trout

2. Commercial updates

- Add lying on commercial license application (35 points/revocation)
- Add use of unattended gill net in the Chesapeake Bay and its tidal tributaries (5 points/no immediate suspension)

3. Housekeeping updates: References to regulations which have been removed or amended will be updated.

Why is this change necessary?

The department regularly updates its penalty schedule under the advice of the Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission/Tidal Fisheries Advisory Commission Joint Penalty Workgroup. The changes the department is considering are recommendations of the workgroup.

For the recreational updates, the department has seen an increase in land-based shark fishing in certain areas. This activity is legal, but comes with a number of requirements for the safe handling of sharks to ensure their maximum survivability following being caught. The workgroup recommended imposing a suspension only for a second or subsequent violation at this time to prioritize education of offenders first. For the possession of fish with head or tail removed while fishing in nontidal waters, it is important to ensure that fish with size limits are of legal size. Adding a suspension for this type of violation will help to ensure better compliance with current size limits. Based on a prohibition in the Maryland Annotated Code, black bass (largemouth and smallmouth bass) may only be caught in nontidal waters with hook and line. The department also has a regulation prohibiting the shooting of black bass with projectile gears. This action would add the statutory violation to the penalty schedule. If the violation were charged as a violation of the gear regulation it would potentially result in either a 180 day suspension or a 1 year suspension; the workgroup recommended adding the statutory violation at the lower of the two possible penalties. The two trout violations being added to the penalty schedule will result in greater parity in administrative penalties being levied on violations. Violations in delayed harvest areas currently result in a one year suspension while there is no current administrative penalty for violations in catch-and-release areas. This action will create an identical penalty for similar violations in the two areas. The department currently has rules regarding the culling of two species: striped bass and trout. A striped bass culling violation

currently results in a one year suspension; this action will add an identical penalty for culling trout.

For the commercial updates, the department has statutory authority to suspend or revoke an individual's tidal fish license and their entitlement to engage in commercial fishing activities both for any violation recommended by the penalty workgroup and for a small number of specific violations described in statute. The recommendations of the penalty workgroup are reflected in the penalty schedule in regulation. The department recently encountered the issue of a nonresident lying on their commercial fishing license application, presenting themselves as residents, in order to illegally obtain commercial oyster and clam harvester licenses. In order to be as transparent as possible, the department and the workgroup both thought it would be best to add the penalty for the offense to the schedule in regulation, even though the department has the authority to suspend or revoke without doing so. Setting the penalty at 35 points, which results in revocation of the license and the individual's entitlement to engage in commercial fishing activities, will ensure that individuals who are convicted of illegally obtaining a license will never be able participate in that fishery in the future either. Finally, the addition of an unattended gill net violation in the Chesapeake Bay and its tidal tributaries as a 5 point violation will help to ensure greater compliance with the attendance requirements for gill nets. Because 5 points on a licensee's record does not result in an immediate suspension, it essentially will act as an enhancement to the penalty for other violations committed and provide an incentive to avoid further illegal behavior during the time period the points are on the individual's license record.

Who will this affect?

Individuals who violate Maryland fisheries laws.

When would this be effective?

The department projects that this change could be effective in the spring of 2023. However, the exact date cannot be determined. The department will follow our normal proposal procedures if this concept moves forward.

Has this change been discussed with stakeholders?

1. Penalty Workgroup in June, 2022.
2. Discussed at Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission (SFAC) and Tidal Fish Advisory Commission (TFAC) July 2022 meetings as part of the workgroup reports.
